



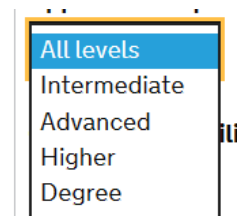
Use Browse or enter Keyword to select a job field that interests you.

## FURTHER ADVICE

If you are interested in an apprenticeship after GCSEs or after A Levels, get in the habit of researching this website even if you are not ready to apply to get feel for what is available.

Register for updates of vacancies in the field that interests you

In some cases you make your application just 6-8 weeks before the apprenticeship starts.

If you apply for an apprenticeship after GCSEs, instead of going to Sixth Form, ensure you also apply for a place at college or sixth form as a back-up in case you do not secure an apprenticeship.

If you apply for an apprenticeship after A Levels instead of going to university, ensure you also apply for a place at university as a back-up in case you do not secure an apprenticeship.

Training Schemes and sponsored degrees for students with A Level are not all advertised on apprenticeships.gov. For these opportunities, look at online careers portals such as [The Big Choice](#), [Student Ladder](#) and [Not Going To Uni](#).
